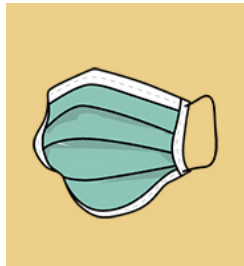

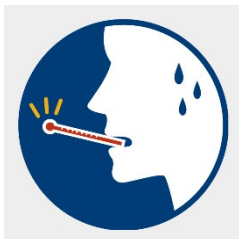
Hand Sanitizer & Cleaning
